eBooks

You have access to 55,320 e-Books (electronic books). To access the collection, open up your Blackboard (Bb) account and click on the Student Support tab. Use your college email information to log in to any of the resources listed under the e-book section.

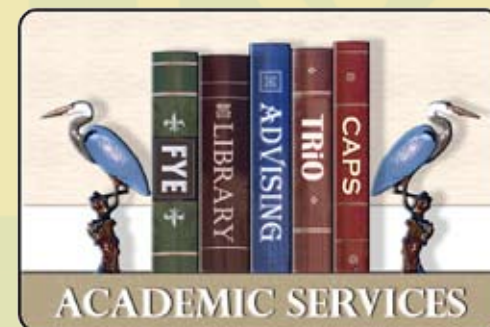

How do I access the Student Information System?

To access the Student Information System go to: <http://greatbay.edu/sis>

After the SIS site loads, click on the "Enter Secure Area" link. Your User ID is your Student ID Number. If it is the first time you log in, your initial PIN will either be your six digit date of birth or the last six numbers of your Student ID Number.

How do I log into Blackboard to see my classes?

In the address bar of your internet browser, go to: <http://ccsnh.blackboard.com/>

Your log in information is the following:

User ID: first initial + last name + last 5 digits of Student ID Number

Default Password: last 6 digits of your Student ID Number

For example: If Mary Smith is the student and her user id is @12345678 then she would log in like this:

User id: msmith45678

Password: 345678
