### **Renewal Application Instructions**

**It's time to do your 2011-12 FAFSA for the upcoming financial aid year -  
Summer 2011, Fall 2011, and Spring 2012**

Please complete the FAFSA at: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/> . The 2011-12 FAFSA will ask for information on your 2010 income. We recommend doing the FAFSA after you finish your 2010 tax return. Our school code is:

**002583**

**The *priority* deadline is March 15, 2011.** If you complete the FAFSA by this date, you will be considered for all grant and loan funds we have available. If you complete the FAFSA after March 15, some grant funds may be expended; the remainder will be awarded first-come, first-served.

**If you need help with your FAFSA,** call 603 427 7610, email [askgreatbay@ccsnh.edu](mailto:askgreatbay@ccsnh.edu), or bring your 2010 tax forms to our College Services One Stop counter on Fridays, and we will help you complete the FAFSA.

**We urge you to do the FAFSA before May 1. That is the final (and firm) deadline for state grant programs.**

#### **NEW for 2011-12**

**PLUS Loans (Parent Loans to Undergraduate Students)** will require a completed FAFSA.

**Direct Student Loans** (the new name for the Stafford Loan Program): If you **did not borrow** (at Great Bay Community College) under the Direct Student Loan program in 2010-11, you will need to go to <http://www.studentloans.gov> to complete Entrance Loan Counseling and a Master Promissory Note.

If you borrowed under the Direct Student Loan Program at Great Bay in 2010-11, your Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling will be valid for 2011-12, and you will not need to redo them.
